Woodley Island Marina Maintenance Dredging - Disposal at HOODS

## Gentlemen:

We request that a Notice to Mariners be posted regarding our dredging operations at the Woodley Island Marina. Our clamshell dredge, "Excavator Barge Horton" will carry out dredging operations. Our scow fleet will consist of 1 split hull scows. The capacity of the scow is 2,00CY.

The tow tug "Julius Brusco" or comparable will serve as our tow tug during disposal operations. The material from Woodley Island Marina will be disposed of offshore at the Humboldt Open Ocean Disposal Site (HOODS) as directed by the Dredged Material Management Office (DMMO). All equipment will monitor Channels 13, 16, & 80.

Our dredging operations will commence on or about October 9, 2023, and will be completed by November 15, 2023. During this time, we will be operating 24 hours / 7 days / week around the Woodley Island Marina (approximately 40°48′30″N, 124°09′46.27″W) with dredging and disposal operations.

Our superintendent will be Mr. Jeremy Biggs. He can be reached at (415) 720-3807. Mariners are advised to use extreme caution while transiting the dredge area.
