A: Page 19 of the RFQ provided this link: "PIDP 2023 Grant Application found at: <u>https://humboldtbay.org/sites/humboldtbay.org/files/Humboldt%20POWERED%20FY2023%20PIDP%20Proposal%20%2</u> 8excludes%20KMZ%20files%29 reducedfilesize.pdf".

That document is the grant application that was fully approved by the Federal Maritime Administration (MARAD). Per page v of that document, the total Project Cost is \$10,926,060 (total Federal Funding = \$8,672,986; and total non-Federal funding = \$2,253,074). No District or other funds will be added to that amount. The District may withhold some of the total funds for grant administration. So, the total project budget is a maximum of \$10,926,060.
