NOTICE IS HEARBY GIVEN that the Northcoast Regional Land Trust, has applied for a permit from the Humboldt Bay Harbor, Recreation and Conservation District for the Martin Slough Enhancement Project located near the intersection of Pine Hill Rd. and Meyer's Ave., and along Fairview Dr., Eureka, CA. APNs: 305-021-011, -010; 302-161-003; 301-211-006, -007, -001; 301-031-008, -018, -013; 305-031-001.

The purpose of the Martin Slough Enhancement Project is to improve aquatic and riparian habitat and reduce flooding throughout the project area. The project will restore and enhance approximately 8,000 feet of Martin Slough, its tributaries and associated riparian and wetland habitat. The exact location and nature of the proposed project are on file in the Humboldt Bay Harbor, Recreation and Conservation District office, 601 Startare Drive, Woodley Island Marina, Eureka.
