

HUMBOLDT BAY HARBOR, RECREATION AND CONSERVATION DISTRICT NOTICE OF PUBLIC REVIEW AND SPECIAL MEETING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Humboldt Bay Harbor, Recreation and Conservation District will conduct a public meeting on **Thursday, December 8, 2016 at 12:00pm** at the Woodley Island Marina Meeting Room at 601 Startare Drive, Eureka, CA., to collect public comments on its US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Brownfields Cleanup Grant Application proposal, with its Draft Analysis of Brownfield Cleanup Alternatives (ABCA) report. The District proposes to cleanup three debris piles at its Redwood Marine Terminal II (RMT II) site; cleanup is proposed to include identifying portions that are contaminated, and separating hazardous from non-hazardous materials. Non-hazardous materials will be reused as fill on site, while hazardous materials will be properly disposed at Class I or II facilities. Copies of the grant proposal and the ABCA report are online at the Harbor District's website and at the District's front office at 601 Startare Drive, Eureka. The District will accept comments on the grant proposal and the ABCA report at the meeting. Comments will also be accepted via email at jcrider@humbolddbay.org.
