NOTICE OF APPLICATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Pacific Gas & Electric (PG&E) has applied for a permit from the Humboldt Bay Harbor, Recreation and Conservation District for the PG&E Pipeline Repairs Project. The project covers three sites near Humboldt Bay, CA:

- Replacement at Ryan Slough (R-519) includes APNs 017-151-005, 017-151-004, 017-151-007, 016-171-004. The project site is in Eureka where L-137C crosses the Ryan Slough, just to the north of the Myrtle Avenue bridge.
- Decommissioning and Removal at Freshwater Slough (R-354) includes APNs 017-121-005, 014-301-003, 017-131-003. The project site is located along Freshwater Slough, approximately 0.5 miles east of Eureka. The location is approximately 0.5 miles upstream from its confluence with Eureka Slough that continues approximately an additional 1.7 miles northwest into Humboldt Bay.
- Sinkhole Repair at Ryan Creek (RT-102) includes APN 017-031-013. The project site is located west of Mitchell Road in Eureka along Ryan Creek.
