### NOTICE OF APPLICATION

**NOTICE IS HEARBY GIVEN that the City of Eureka** has applied for a permit from the Humboldt Bay Harbor, Recreation and Conservation District for the Elk River Estuary Enhancement and Waterfront Trail Extension Project located along U.S. Highway 101 and Tooby Road between Humboldt Hill Rd. and Herrick Ave.

Proposed Project: To restore/enhance estuary and inter-tidal wetland habitats of the Elk River. Including: ~1-mile extension of Waterfront Trail, construction of a non-motorized boat launch, causeways and viewing platforms, and a trail head parking area off Tooby Road. The project may also create approximately 2.8 miles of navigable channels connected to Elk River Slough. The exact location and nature of the proposed project are on file in the Humboldt Bay Harbor, Recreation and Conservation District office, 601 Startare Drive, Woodley Island Marina, Eureka.

Interested parties are invited to submit in writing any comments or requests for a public hearing relative to the proposed activity to the Humboldt Bay Harbor, Recreation and Conservation District, P.O.
