NOTICE OF APPLICATION

NOTICE IS HEARBY GIVEN that Pacific Affiliates has applied for a permit from the Humboldt Bay Harbor, Recreation and Conservation District for the Schneider Dock Maintenance Dredging Project located along the eastern shore of the North Humboldt Bay Channel in the City of Eureka at 990 West Waterfront Drive.

Proposed Project: Maintenance dredging is proposed that will restore and maintain sufficient draft depth for moorage and shipping at Schneider Dock. Dredging volume will not exceed 5,000 cubic yards per 12-month period, and the total volume dredged under this permit will not exceed 10,000 cubic yards. Dredging will be performed using an excavator and/or crane with a clamshell bucket positioned on a floating work barge and materials will be deposited at the Humboldt Open Ocean Disposal Site (HOODS) located three nautical miles northwest of the Humboldt Bay entrance. The exact location and nature of the proposed project are on file in the Humboldt Bay Harbor, Recreation and Conservation District office, 601 Startare Drive, Woodley Island Marina, Eureka.

Interested parties are invited to submit in writing any comments or requests for a public hearing relative to the proposed activity to the Humboldt Bay Harbor, Recreation and Conservation District, P.O. Box 1030, Eureka, California 95502 or districtplanner@humboldtby.org. Written comments should be submitted no later than thirty (30) days from the date of this notice.
